## Dr. Snyder's Mobile # will be given to you on your vasectomy day. Follow these instructions and you will have a virtually pain-free recovery!

- 1) Be Sedentary at home the first day. Reasonable alcohol intake is permitted during recovery.
- 2) Activity can be increased from being sedentary beginning the day after the vasectomy.
- 3) No strenuous activity, long walks or squatting for 5 days. No working out for 7 days. It is common to have a temporary increase in your discomfort as you increase your activity, but the pain does go away with enough time, so don't worry.
- 4) Ice or frozen peas are not needed unless swelling or pain (usually from over activity) occurs. Crushed ice in a baggie wrapped in a tee shirt makes a good ice pack if needed.
- 5) Ibuprofen (Advil<sup>TM</sup>) 600 mg (3 pills) scheduled 3 times daily for a full week is recommended if discomfort persists. As an alternative Acetaminophen (Tylenol<sup>TM</sup>) may be used.
- 6) Wear briefs for support indefinitely. Boxer wearers may want to switch to briefs forever. We no longer supply an athletic supporter, even though the video says we do.
- 7) Keep the area dry overnight. Wait and shower the morning after. Remove the gauze, then replace it after towel drying. Avoid soaking in any water until the skin opening is well-healed.
- 8) Do not scrub or place ointment on the skin opening as it can delay healing.
- 9) You may have sex or masturbate 3 days after the procedure if you feel up to it. It is possible to see blood in your semen within the first few weeks, but it will go away with time.
- 10) It is common to see bruising anywhere in the region and may not appear until days after.
- 11) Text Dr. Snyder for severe pain, rapid swelling, fever, or expanding redness near the skin opening or any other signs of infection. Sending a picture can be very helpful.
- 12) Sperm Granuloma may develop following a vasectomy. This is *NORMAL* and requires no treatment. The lump(s) that are *above* the testes may never go away because it is scar tissue in the scrotum from vasectomy. Use Ibuprofen per item # 3 above if ever tender.
- 13) Do not rely on your vasectomy for birth control until you have had a negative PVSA!
- 14) Post Vasectomy Semen Analysis (PVSA) is included. You have registered for testing with your phone in the office using the QR code that was provided. A kit will be mailed from our office 2 months after your vasectomy. It arrives in a white envelope the size of a greeting card and includes all materials and instructions needed for you to return a specimen. If you think it could have been lost in the mail, please text Dr. Snyder about it, and provide your name and vasectomy date. Once you have mailed the specimen back, it may take up to 2 weeks to get a link to the results via email. Your date of birth will open the results. Please don't inquire about pending results unless 2 weeks have passed since you mailed it.
